DESCRIPTION OF REDUCTION ISSUE:

This is a recurring General Revenue reduction of 15 Law Enforcement Officer Positions and associated Salaries and Benefits. These positions are assigned to Agricultural Interdiction Stations throughout the State.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

This reduction would have a significant impact on the Office of Agricultural Law Enforcement and our ability to perform our core mission. In order to meet minimum staffing requirements at our 23 Interdiction Stations 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, the Bureau of Uniform Services must employ 190 Law Enforcement Officers. We currently have 183 Law Enforcement Officer Positions, including those assigned to VACIS units. Therefore overtime is required to meet minimum staffing. Eliminating 15 of these positions would greatly impede our ability to meet minimum staffing to perform our core mission. Adjusting the schedule for vacancies, training assignments and leave requests is already a challenge. Eliminating 15 positions would cause overtime to surge, would lead to our inability to grant leave and would cause leave balances to accumulate quickly, creating an unfunded liability.

This reduction is based on Salaries and Benefits calculated at the annual minimum.

The Bureau of Investigative Services lost 21 positions in FY 2012-13: four (4) Investigator positions were eliminated and one Investigator and 16 CARL Officers were transferred to the Fish and Wildlife Commission. Cutting additional Investigators, whether regulatory or criminal, will further decrease our ability to assist the regulatory divisions within the Department and will result in fewer investigations. It will also decrease our ability to assist local law enforcement.

DESCRIPTION OF REDUCTION ISSUE:

The closure of two (2) of the Division's eight (8) regional offices would be necessary to achieve a 5% reduction of the Division's FY 2014-15 recurring operating budget of \$1,695,546. This significant reduction is the least harmful option available and would eliminate 20 positions (7 investigative / 13 non-investigative), 17 of which are filled. The remaining six regional offices would allow continued operations in North Florida (Ft. Walton Beach, Tallahassee and Jacksonville), Central Florida (Tampa) and South Florida (West Palm Beach and Miami).

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

Significant - Shutting these offices would have a substantial negative impact on our regulation and enforcement responsibilities, as 7 of the Division's 30 investigator positions would be eliminated, resulting in a re-distribution of over 5,800 inspections and investigations of the Bureau's remaining 23 investigators covering 67 counties. Annual inspections and investigations per investigator would have to increase by approximately 30%. In addition, the 23 remaining inspectors' geographic territories would increase significantly and the non-investigative positions which provide administrative support as well as process concealed weapon (CW) license applications would also be eliminated. Negative impacts include the real potential for a significant increase in unlicensed activity as individuals posing as security guards, private investigators and recovery agents are much more likely to engage in these regulated activities without a license, in addition to those licensees simply not renewing an existing license, if not being monitored for compliance.

The "fast track" issuance of concealed weapon (CW) licenses processed through the regional offices would be significantly curtailed; 18% of the 95,717 CW license applications processed in the regional offices in FY 2012-13 were processed in these 2 offices-a substantial reduction of a very popular program. This 5% reduction plan would also impair the Division's ability to issue CW license renewals in the regional offices, as recently implemented and very favorably

DESCRIPTION OF REDUCTION ISSUE:

This issue reduces \$300,000 in the Natural Gas Vehicle Rebates category from the General Revenue Fund. In Fiscal Year 2013-14, the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Office of Energy received a \$6 million appropriation in General Revenue to provide rebates to eligible applicants with three (3) or more fleet vehicles that have converted their diesel and gasoline powered vehicles to natural gas. The amount of \$300,000 represents 5% of the \$6 million dollar General Revenue appropriation.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

This reduction will have a moderate impact by reducing the Natural Gas Vehicle Rebates Program appropriation of \$6 million down to \$5.7 million and thereby decreasing the number of rebates available to Florida businesses and local governments from 240 down to 228. This reduction will result in the loss of twelve (12) natural gas rebates at a cost of \$25,000 each that will no longer be provided. Also this reduction will have a similar impact on the state of Florida's efforts, pursuant to Chapter 377.810, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 2013-198, Laws of Florida to decrease reliance on imported diesel and gasoline fuels.

CALCULATION OF REDUCTION AMOUNT:

The amount of \$300,000 represents 5% of the \$6 million dollar General Revenue appropriation and meets the 5% target reduction.

DESCRIPTION OF REDUCTION ISSUE:

This will eliminate the Florida Forest Service's Wildfire Management Teams, (WMT) which are a critical reinforcement on wildfires. This program reduction will equal to a total of \$1,553,158. \$1,048,492 in the General Revenue Fund, consisting of \$1,039,685 (23.0 FTE positions) in Salaries and Benefits, \$6,500 in Expenses and \$2,307 in Contractual Services. \$502,956 in the Incidental TF, consisting of \$500,000 in Expenses and \$2,956 in Contractual Services. \$1,710 in the Ag. Emergency TF under the On-Call Category.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

This reduction will significantly impact Florida Forest Service's ability to suppress wildfires that escape initial attack. These teams are critical to keeping fires from growing into large campaign wildfires that become very costly and destructive.

The mission of the Wildfire Management Teams is to provide assistance to each Forestry District/Center within the region in accomplishing the wildfire hazard mitigation goals as set forth in the District/Center Annual Operational Plan. While the primary mission of a Wildfire Management Team is protecting Florida's communities with wildfire hazard mitigation, every Florida Forest Service employee has a responsibility to support and participate in wildfire suppression activities as the situation demands. The organizational structure, resource complement, and self-sufficient nature of a Wildfire Management Team allows for quick mobilization as a Strike Team or Task Force throughout the region in support of fire suppression or other emergency operations.

This program of wildland vegetative fuel management in and around the wildland urban interface minimizes the likelihood that homes and property will be damaged or destroyed by wildfire. All wildfire hazard fuel reduction conducted by the Wildfire Management Team will be within interface areas where structures are reasonably determined to be in danger of

wildfire. This work will include prescribed fire operations, mechanical fuel reduction (mowing, masticating, roller chopping), pre-suppression fire line construction, herbicide application or a combination of treatment types.

Since their establishment these teams have treated 149,199 acres and provided a reduced risk of wildfire damage to 100,494 structures. The loss of these teams would increase the chances of a home or business being damaged or destroyed by a wildfire. These untreated areas also would require additional personnel and equipment, either from the Florida Forest Service or local Fire Department, to provide more protection than would be needed if the areas had been treated. These full-time positions work on wildfire prevention, suppression and all other hazard emergency incident response.

CALCULATION OF REDUCTION AMOUNT:

The calculation is based on actual Salaries and Benefits paid to the Fire Management Team positions and their operating budget for fiscal year 13-14.

STATUTORY CHANGE(S): No statutory change is required to implement this reduction.

DESCRIPTION OF REDUCTION ISSUE:

This cut of \$627,208 will close all recreation areas within the Withlacoochee State Forest. This requests is made up of: \$214,358 in General Revenue Fund, \$202,898 (12.0 FTE positions) in Salaries and Benefits, \$11,460 in Expenses; \$316,572 in Incidental Trust Fund, \$215,572 in Salaries and Benefits, \$95,000 in Expenses, \$6,000 in Contractual Services; \$96,278 in Conservation and Recreation Lands Trust Fund (CARL) \$92,625 Salaries and Benefits and \$3,653 in Expenses.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

This would have a significant impact on Florida's Citizens. Withlacoochee State Forest (WSF) is located near several metropolitan centers (Tampa, St. Petersburg, etc.) and received 1,026,161 State Forest visitors during fiscal year 2012-13. If the recreational facilities at Withlacoochee State Forest were closed, 159,604 acres of public land would be closed to public access. The State of Florida, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and Florida Forest Service would lose \$765,556 in annual revenue based on FY 2012-2013 figures. A total of 16 different recreational sites would no longer be accessible to the visitors. Hiking, biking, horseback riding, canoeing/kayaking, picnicking, hunting and off-highway vehicle riding opportunities that are current available to the public would be eliminated.

This will eliminate the Florida Forest Service's Road Crew Program. This program reduction will equal to a total of \$345,224 in Conservation and Recreation Lands Trust Fund (CARL), under the following categories: \$206,415 in Salaries and Benefits, \$136,629 in Expenses and \$2,180 in Contractual Services.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

This would have a significant impact as the Florida Forest Service maintain a total of 3,632 miles and 125 bridges throughout the state forests. This crew is capable of traveling throughout the State Forest system to handle the major road repair projects that are often beyond the capabilities of the local State Forest maintenance personnel. Without their added assistance, many miles of forest roads would not be open to the public or available to accommodate timber harvesting and reforestation activities. Based on current figures, FFS cost per mile to rebuild, reshape the ditches and install culverts is approximately \$73,909 per mile, versus \$245,000 if contracted out. This is a cost savings to the State of \$171,091 per mile of repaired road.

The Road Crew is a unit that was established over 10 years ago to assist Florida Forest Service on the management of the mounting road repair problems that derive from the large amount of state's wildland acreage. These roads are often in varying degrees of disrepair due to heavy rain, floods, timber logging and recreational visitor traffic. There is a constant need for culverts replacement, washouts repairs and ditches maintenance. The Road Crew unit is very knowledgeable and familiar with forestry Best Management Practices in order to comply with rules of the various Water Management Districts. These roads are necessary for emergency access, fire protection, forest management activities, school busses, public recreation, timber harvesting and access to private in holdings.

The Food Laboratories are mission critical and have a significant food safety function in the state of Florida. The elimination of six (6) positions in this bureau will result in a reduction in state samples and analytical tests; loss of ability to analyze nutrient claims (e.g. fat content, sodium); loss of ability to analyze for certain hazardous substances (e.g. mercury content in fish and heavy metals); loss of ability to prevent fraudulently identified fish, honey, vanilla, syrup; overall reduction in consumer based laboratory services. The reduction of \$413,107 consists of various operating categories within the Division of Food Safety and Inspection program from the Federal Grants Trust Fund. This issue will reduce \$300,000 in Salaries and Benefits, \$63,107 in Other Personal Services and \$50,000 in Contracted Services.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

Minimal Impact: The reduction of \$413,107 in Federal Grants Trust Fund authority would have a minimal impact on the overall grant programs currently being administered. The Division has reverted excess spending authority in previous years in the Federal Grants Trust Fund in Salaries and Benefits, OPS and Contracted Services categories and has projected to revert additional authority in Fiscal Year 2013-14. This reduction in spending is primarily due to federal sequestration actions taken upon all of the divisions' renewal and new grant funding opportunities and the loss of the Microbiological Data Program (MDP) grant this year.

This issue reduces the Aid to Local Governments for the Mosquito Control Program in the amount of \$744,400 from the General Inspection Trust Fund.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

This reduction would be a significant impact to the program. This would reduce the amount available for distribution to local governments and mosquito control research by \$744,400. The funds allocated for Fiscal Year 2013-14, provide for overhead for administrative costs, mosquito control research, support of new personnel at the Florida Medical Entomology Laboratory, and distribution to county mosquito control programs, with approximately \$29,000 provided per program. Amounts distributed after this reduction would depend on the total amount appropriated by the Legislature for Fiscal Year 2014-15. The reduction of two (2) petroleum inspectors will cause an estimated yearly decrease of approximately 9,760 petroleum inspections. This reduction would expand the recurring inspection of gasoline pumps, which are now inspected every 18-24 months, to 26 months. Consumer complaints would be investigated, but targeted response time (currently 2 days) would increase to 3-4 days.

This issue is to reduce spending authority from the Citrus Inspection Trust Fund (CITF), Special Category Citrus Marketing Orders. Funds for the marketing orders are paid by farmers via a per-box voluntary assessment the industry approved to pay for research. None of the funds are used directly by the Department of Agriculture. Rather, the advisory council recommends to the Commissioner of Agriculture which research projects they wish to fund. This reduction represents a 5% reduction of the spending authority provided for this purpose.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

The impact of this issue is minimal in that they do not bring in as much in assessments due to the various citrus diseases that have reduced the number of boxes of citrus being processed. \$3.1 million was reverted in FY 2012-13. If the assessments increase and authority decreases, the industries will be unable to fully utilize funds they voluntarily pay into the marketing order, thereby reducing the amount and scope of research and marketing conducted on its behalf. All activities funded through the marketing order are conducted by entities associated directly with the industry.

In addition, the Division would have to cut one (1) laboratory FTE in recurring GR salaries in the amount of \$64,440.

IMPACT OF THE REDUCTION:

A \$166,888 reduction for the Division of Animal Industry would have a significant impact on the division's ability to achieve its mission of the prevention and control of serious animal diseases. The Division would have to cut approximately four (4) FTE in the Bureau of Animal Disease Control (BADC). Reduction in BADC field staff would result in reduced disease surveillance at animal sales across the state as well as reduced site visits to premises with livestock where disease monitoring, sample collection and quarantine assessments are conducted. Specific programs that would be impacted are weekend small animal sales inspections (reduce program) and swine field inspections (reduce program). The introduction of animal diseases could have a catastrophic economic impact on the state of Florida. Without adequate surveillance and control for these diseases designated as dangerous transmissible diseases, marketing channels for movement out of state can be expected to be closed for Florida livestock and poultry in the event of a disease outbreak.

IMPACT OF THIS REDUCTION:

Operations Analyst II - The Operations Analyst II position is the only state asset (our eyes and ears) we have involved in the Mediterranean fruit fly (Medfly) Preventative Release Program (PRP) Rearing Facility. By eliminating this position the State will no longer have an employee involved in the quality control and rearing / release technique development of the Florida Medfly program.

Agricultural Technician III - This position is responsible for many different specialized areas including: building security and after hours project monitoring, fumigation, fruit fly methods development, imported fire ant certification, hazardous chemical disposal and cactus moth rearing. By eliminating this position we will no longer be able to test soils for imported fire ant certification; we will be unable to do the necessary work on methods development of fruit fly trapping and eradication techniques; and our security schedule will no longer cover full weekends. This lack of security and project monitoring during the weekends could lead to catastrophic losses in our many biological control programs. All fumigation, hazardous chemical disposal and construction and design projects will have to be handled by one employee if

This certification accounts for all plant material exported to these markets without which Florida producers would be significantly impacted.

Environmental Specialist I - The loss of an inspector position would have a major impact and is proposed only out of the necessity to meet the required 5% reduction target. A reduction of one plant inspector would have a significant impact on the services provided to customers, particularly the nursery industry and other export agribusinesses that rely on inspection services to retain certification and to allow for intra/interstate and international movement of regulated commodities. The Division lost four inspector FTE's in the 2011 budget reduction. Other duties include tending of fruit fly traps and assistance in special projects.
