- HB 0009 Relating to Legislative Session Dates** Nuñez
Legislative Session Dates: Fixes date for convening regular session of Legislature in even-numbered years. Effective Date: upon becoming a law
- HB 0023 Relating to Canned or Perishable Food Distributed Free of Charge** Rogers
Canned or Perishable Food Distributed Free of Charge: Limits liability of public schools with respect to donation of canned or perishable food to charitable or nonprofit organizations. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- HB 0041 Relating to Florida Law Enforcement Officers' Hall of Fame** Campbell
Florida Law Enforcement Officers' Hall of Fame: Establishes Florida Law Enforcement Officers' Hall of Fame; designates location; provides procedures for selection, nomination, & induction; requires FDLE to adopt rules; provides appropriation. Effective Date: October 1, 2014
- HB 0047 Relating to Spiny Lobster** Raschein
Spiny Lobster: Provides penalties for certain violations relating to possession of spiny lobster. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- HB 0053 Relating to Inmate Reentry** Stone
Inmate Reentry: Waives fee for identification cards issued to certain inmates; authorizes issuance of temporary permits in certain circumstances; waives fee for replacement driver licenses for certain inmates; requires waiver of fees for certain inmates receiving copy of birth certificate; requires DOC to work with other agencies in acquiring necessary documents for certain inmates to acquire identification card or driver license before release; provides exceptions; requires DOC to provide specified assistance to inmates born outside this state; authorizes DOC to operate male & female faith- & character-based institutions. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- HB 0059 Relating to Offenses Against Unborn Children** Ahern
Offenses Against Unborn Children: Designates act as "Florida Unborn Victims of Violence Act"; provides rule of construction that person who engages in conduct that violates Florida Criminal Code or criminal offense defined by another statute & causes death of, or bodily injury to unborn child commits separate offense if such offense is not specifically provided for; provides for penalties; specifies that certain types of knowledge or intent are not necessary for such offense; provides exceptions; revises definitions & terminology. Effective Date: October 1, 2014
- SB 0086 Relating to Dentists** Latvala
Dentists; Prohibiting a contract between a health insurer, prepaid limited health service organization, or health maintenance organization, and a dentist from requiring the dentist to provide services at a fee set by the insurer or organization under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014

- HB 0089 Relating to Threatened Use of Force** Combee
Threatened Use of Force: Prohibiting the court from imposing certain mandatory minimum sentences if the court makes specified written findings; applying provisions relating to the use of force in defense of persons to the threatened use of force; applying presumption relating to the use of deadly force to the threatened use of deadly force in the defense of a residence and similar circumstances; applying immunity provisions that relate to the use of force to the threatened use of force; providing that a person is not justified in the threatened use of force to resist an arrest by a law enforcement officer, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law
- HB 0097 Relating to Access to Health Care for the Underserved** Magar
Access to Health Care for the Underserved: Extending the period of time for which a health care provider remains an agent of the state after an individual under his or her care is deemed ineligible; requiring that a contract with a governmental contractor for health care services include a provision allowing a voluntary contribution toward certain dental laboratory work; delaying the future repeal of provisions authorizing the health access dental license, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- SB 0102 Relating to Drivers Leaving the Scene of a Crash** Diaz de la Portilla
Drivers Leaving the Scene of a Crash; Creating the “Aaron Cohen Life Protection Act”; requiring the driver of a vehicle involved in a crash that results in serious bodily injury to a person to immediately stop the vehicle and remain at the scene of the crash; providing that a person commits a felony of the second degree if he or she fails to stop the vehicle and remain at the scene of the crash until specified requirements are fulfilled; requiring the court to revoke for at least 3 years the driver license of a person convicted of leaving the scene of a crash involving injury, serious bodily injury, or death, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0106 Relating to County Employees** Dean
County Employees; Providing that the governing body of a county has authority to determine available benefits of county employees; specifying the applicability of provisions to such employees, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- HB 0115 Relating to Public Meetings/University Direct Support Organization** Pigman
Public Meetings/University Direct-Support Organization: Provides exemption from public meeting requirements for any portion of meeting of board of directors of university DSO, or of executive committee or other committees of board, at which proposal seeking research funding from organization or plan or program for initiating or supporting research is discussed; provides for review & repeal of exemption; provides statement of public necessity. Effective Date: October 1, 2014
- HB 0117 Relating to Public Retirement Plans** Ray
Public Retirement Plans: Specifies applicability of ch. 185, F.S., to certain consolidated governments; provides that consolidated government that has entered into interlocal agreement to provide police protection services to municipality within its boundaries is eligible to receive premium taxes reported for municipality; authorizes municipality receiving police protection services to enact an ordinance levying tax as provided by law; including certain consolidated governments under provisions authorizing imposition of state excise tax on casualty insurance premiums covering certain property. Effective Date: July 1, 2014

- SB 0118 Relating to National Retail Sales Tax** Hays
National Retail Sales Tax; Urging Congress to repeal all taxes on income and enact a national retail sales tax as specified in H.R. 25, the Fair Tax Act of 2013, etc.
- SB 0132 Relating to Specialty License Plates** Latvala
Specialty License Plates; Authorizing the collection of annual use fees for the Fallen Law Enforcement Officers license plate, the Florida Sheriffs Association license plate, the Keiser University license plate, and the Moffitt Cancer Center license plate; revising provisions relating to the distribution of annual use funds to the Astronauts Memorial Foundation, Inc., for the Challenger/Columbia specialty license plate; requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to discontinue the plates under certain circumstances; establishing an annual use fee for the plates; providing for the distribution of use fees received from the sale of such plates, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect October 1, 2014
- SB 0156 Relating to Motor Vehicle and Mobile Home Taxes, Fees, and Surcharges** Negron
Motor Vehicle and Mobile Home Taxes, Fees, and Surcharges; Reducing the amount of the additional registration fee used to fund the Florida Real Time Vehicle Information System; reducing the service charge imposed on an application for an original or duplicate license plate, or specified registration stickers or certificates; reducing surcharges imposed on a license tax; reenacting and amending provisions relating to special vehicle license plates for the Governor and federal and state legislators, to incorporate the amendment made to s. 320.06, F.S., in a reference thereto, etc. Effective Date: 9/1/2014
- HB 0175 Relating to Emergency Communication System** Steube
Emergency Communication System: Revises provisions relating to Emergency Communications Number E911 System; revises provisions for administration, distribution, & use of E911 fee; provides for prepaid wireless E911 fee; revises provisions for accounting, distribution, use, & auditing of Emergency Communications Number E911 System Fund. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- HB 0177 Relating to Pub. Rec./Prepaid Wireless E911 Fee** Steube
Pub. Rec./Prepaid Wireless E911 Fee: Provides exemption from public records requirements for proprietary confidential business information submitted by wireless service provider to DOR; authorizes department to share such information with Secretary of Management Services & E911 Board; provides for future legislative review & repeal; provides statement of public necessity; provides contingent effective date. Effective Date: on the same date that HB 175 or similar legislation takes effect
- SB 0188 Relating to Education Data Privacy** Hukill
Education Data Privacy; Providing for annual notice to K-12 students and parents of rights relating to education records; providing limitations on the collection of information and the disclosure of confidential and exempt student records; revising provisions relating to the submission of student social security numbers and the assignment of student identification numbers; requiring the Department of Education to establish a process for assigning student identification numbers, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
- SB 0218 Relating to Transportation** Grimsley

Transportation; Requiring utility and television lines to be removed from county roads and highways at no cost to the county if the county finds the lines to be unreasonably interfering with the widening, repair, or reconstruction of any such road; expanding the types of vehicles that may show or display an amber light; authorizing the department to use appropriated funds for the establishment of a statewide system of interconnected multiuse trails; providing an exception for payment of certain utility work necessitated by a project on the State Highway System for municipally owned utilities or county-owned utilities located in rural areas of critical economic concern; authorizing the director of a transportation system or his or her designee to dispose of personal property found on a public transportation system, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014

- SB 0224 Relating to Nicotine Dispensing Devices** Benacquisto
Nicotine Dispensing Devices; Prohibiting the gift of sample nicotine dispensing devices to persons under 18 years of age; prohibiting the selling, delivering, bartering, furnishing, or giving of nicotine dispensing devices to persons under 18 years of age, to which penalties apply; prohibiting persons under 18 years of age from possessing, purchasing, or misrepresenting their age or military service to purchase nicotine dispensing devices; requiring certain signage where a dealer sells nicotine dispensing devices, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- HB 0225 Relating to Child Safety Devices in Motor Vehicles** Perry
Child Safety Devices in Motor Vehicles: Revises child restraint requirements for children who are younger than specified age. Effective Date: January 1, 2015
- SB 0226 Relating to Public Records/Automated License Plate Recognition Systems Exemption** Brandes
Public Records/Automated License Plate Recognition Systems Exemption; Creating a public records exemption for images obtained through the use of an automated license plate recognition system and personal identifying information of an individual in data generated from such images; providing conditions for disclosure of such images and information, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- HB 0227 Relating to Victims of Wrongful Incarceration** Kerner
Victims of Wrongful Incarceration: Provides that wrongfully incarcerated person who was convicted & sentenced to death on or before December 31, 1979, is exempt from certain application procedures for compensation if special prosecutor issues nolle prosequi after reviewing defendant's conviction; provides alternative procedures for applying for compensation; requires claimant to file application with Attorney General's office within specified time; requires application to include certain information & documents; provides that claimant is entitled to compensation if all requirements are met; provides for future repeal of provisions. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- SB 0230 Relating to Orlando-Orange County Expressway Authority** Simmons
Orlando-Orange County Expressway Authority; Renaming the Orlando-Orange County Expressway System as the "Central Florida Expressway System"; providing for the transfer of governance and control, legal rights and powers, responsibilities, terms, and obligations to the authority; extending, to 99 years from 40 years, the term of a lease-purchase agreement; limiting the authority's authority to enter into a lease-purchase agreement; removing the authority and criteria for an authority to waive payment and performance bonds for certain public works

projects that are awarded pursuant to an economic development program, etc. Effective Date:
Upon becoming a law

- HB 0231 Relating to Admissions Tax** Brodeur
Admissions Tax: Revises professional sporting events that are exempt from admissions tax.
Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- SB 0236 Relating to Renaming of Florida College System Institutions** Richter
Renaming of Florida College System Institutions; Renaming Edison State College and Pasco-Hernando Community College as “Florida SouthWestern State College” and “Pasco-Hernando State College,” respectively, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0238 Relating to Public Records/Names of Spouses and Children of Public Defenders and Criminal Conflict and Civil Regional Counsel** Joyner
Public Records/Names of Spouses and Children of Public Defenders and Criminal Conflict and Civil Regional Counsel; Creating an exemption from public records requirements for the names of the spouses and children of current or former public defenders, assistant public defenders, criminal conflict and civil regional counsel, and assistant criminal conflict and civil regional counsel; providing for future review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of necessity, etc. Effective Date: 10/1/2014
- SB 0242 Relating to Security of a Protected Consumer's Information** Detert
Security of a Protected Consumer’s Information; Citing this act as the “Keeping I.D. Safe (KIDS) Act”; authorizing the representative of a protected consumer to place a security freeze on a protected consumer’s consumer report or record; prohibiting a consumer reporting agency from stating or implying that a security freeze reflects a negative credit history or rating; requiring a consumer reporting agency to provide a copy of a consumer report or record to a protected consumer or his or her representative upon request; requiring a consumer reporting agency to remove a security freeze under specified conditions, etc. Effective Date: 9/1/2014
- SB 0256 Relating to Public Records/Forensic Behavioral Health Evaluation** Garcia
Public Records/Forensic Behavioral Health Evaluation; Creating an exemption from public records requirements for a forensic behavioral health evaluation filed with a court; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0260 Relating to Unaccompanied Homeless Youths** Latvala
Unaccompanied Homeless Youths; Defining the term “unaccompanied homeless youth”; providing for a certification; authorizing certain unaccompanied homeless youths to consent to medical, dental, psychological, substance abuse, and surgical diagnosis and treatment, and forensic medical examinations for themselves and for their children in certain circumstances; providing that such consent does not affect the requirements of the Parental Notice of Abortion Act, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- HB 0261 Relating to Constitutional Convention/Single-Subject Requirement for Federal Legislation** Beshears
Constitutional Convention/Single-Subject Requirement for Federal Legislation: Applies to Congress to call convention for purpose of proposing amendment to U.S. Constitution to provide

that every law enacted by Congress shall embrace only one subject, which shall be clearly expressed in its title. Effective Date: Not Specified

- HB 0271 Relating to Workers' Compensation** Cummings
Workers' Compensation: Revises powers of DFS relating to compliance with & enforcement of workers' compensation coverage requirements; provides for stop-work order information to be available on Division of Workers' Compensation's website; revises requirements for release of stop-work orders; revises penalties; revises rate formulas related to determination of compensation for disability & death; revises provisions relating to assessment rate of Special Disability Trust Fund; reduces assessment rate limitation. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- SB 0272 Relating to Water Utilities** Simpson
Water Utilities; Authorizing the Florida Public Service Commission to revoke a certificate of authorization upon receipt of a petition; requiring the commission to consider the quality of water service when fixing rates; requiring the utility to meet with its customers to discuss the costs and benefits of plausible solutions if the commission finds that the utility has failed to meet certain quality of water standards; prohibiting a customer from petitioning the commission to revoke the certificate of authorization of a utility under certain circumstances; authorizing the commission to prescribe penalties for certain failures of the utility, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$224,533.00 Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0280 Relating to Public Records/Participants in Treatment-based Drug Court Programs** Garcia
Public Records/Participants in Treatment-based Drug Court Programs; Exempting from public records requirements information from the screenings for participation in a treatment-based drug court program, substance abuse screenings, behavioral health evaluations, and subsequent treatment status reports regarding a participant or a person considered for participation in a treatment-based program; providing for exceptions to the exemption; providing for retroactive application of the public record exemption; providing for future repeal and legislative review of the exemption under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
- HB 0281 Relating to Keystone XL Pipeline** Hill
Keystone XL Pipeline: Urges the President of the United States to issue final approval for construction & completion of Keystone XL pipeline. Effective Date: Not Specified
- SB 0286 Relating to Concrete Masonry Education** Richter
Concrete Masonry Education; Creating the "Concrete Masonry Education Act"; creating the Florida Concrete Masonry Education Council, Inc.; requiring the council to operate under a written contract with the Department of Economic Opportunity; authorizing the council to accept grants, donations, contributions, and gifts under certain circumstances; providing for collection of a voluntary assessment on concrete masonry units; requiring manufacturers who elect to pay the assessment to commit to paying the assessment for a specified period, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- HB 0287 Relating to Certificates of Need** Artiles
Certificates of Need: Decreases subdistrict average nursing home bed occupancy rate goal that AHCA is required to maintain as goal of its nursing-home-bed-need methodology; provides that replacement of a nursing home or relocation of beds is health-care-related project subject to

expedited review; prohibits agency from approving application for new community nursing home beds under certain circumstances; repeals provisions relating to moratorium on approval of certificates of need for additional community nursing home beds. Effective Date: July 1, 2014

HB 0291 Relating to Warranty Associations

Santiago

Warranty Associations: Authorizes electronic transmission of service agreements & home warranties; provides requirements for electronic transmission; provides notice requirements; revises criteria authorizing premiums of certain service warranty associations to exceed their specified net assets limitations; revises requirements relating to contractual liability policies that insure warranty associations; provides requirements for delivery of service warranty contracts; provides notice requirements. Effective Date: July 1, 2014

SB 0308 Relating to Public Assistance Fraud

Brandes

Public Assistance Fraud; Authorizing the Department of Financial Services to administer oaths and affirmations and issue and serve subpoenas when conducting investigations into public assistance fraud; providing a penalty; providing for award of attorney fees and costs, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014

HB 0313 Relating to Single-Gender Public School Programs

Diaz (M)

Single-Gender Public School Programs: Provides requirements for district school board when establishing gender-specific elementary, middle, or high school; requires school administrative & instructional personnel to participate in professional development; provides accountability requirements. Effective Date: July 1, 2014

SB 0320 Relating to Commercial and Recreational Water Activities

Sachs

Commercial and Recreational Water Activities; Citing this act as the "White-Miskell Act"; prohibiting certain commercial and recreational water activities within certain areas; requiring the operator of a vessel engaged in commercial parasailing to ensure that specified requirements are met; requiring the owner of a vessel engaged in commercial parasailing to obtain and maintain an insurance policy; requiring the operator to have a current and valid license issued by the United States Coast Guard; prohibiting commercial parasailing unless certain equipment is present on the vessel and certain weather conditions are met; requiring that a weather log be maintained and made available for inspection, etc. Effective Date: 10/1/2014

HB 0321 Relating to Title Insurance

Passidomo

Title Insurance: Revising criteria with respect to liabilities charged against assets in determinations of financial condition; specifying the reserves that certain title insurers must set aside after a certain date; specifying that only a licensed and appointed agent or agency is authorized to sell title insurance; revising the application requirements for a title insurance agency license; limiting the remedies available for the breach of duty arising from a title insurance contract, etc. . Effective Date: July 1, 2014

HB 0323 Relating to Pharmacy

La Rosa

Pharmacy : Requiring written prescriptions for specified controlled substances to be dated in a specified format; providing the number of registered pharmacy technicians a licensed pharmacist may supervise if approved by the Board of Pharmacy after considering certain factors; requiring the board to authorize a licensed pharmacist to supervise more than three pharmacy technicians if a licensee is employed by certain entities; requiring a licensee to provide the board with notice of employment status under certain circumstances; authorizing pharmacists to administer

meningococcal and shingles vaccines under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2014

- HB 0325 Relating to Brownfields** Stone
Brownfields: Revises procedures for designation of brownfield areas by local governments; provides certain liability protection against property damages. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- HB 0337 Relating to Florida Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program** Fresen
Florida Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program: Revises procedures for distributing program funds to classroom teachers. Effective Date: July 1, 2014
- HB 0343 Relating to Rental Car Surcharge** Nuñez
Rental Car Surcharge: Provides alternative rental car surcharge rate for use of motor vehicle pursuant to agreement with car-sharing service for less than specified number of hours; defines term "car-sharing service"; provides for applicability. Effective Date: January 1, 2015
- SB 0356 Relating to Regulation of Public Lodging Establishments and Public Food Service Establishments** Thrasher
Regulation of Public Lodging Establishments and Public Food Service Establishments; Revising the permitted scope of local laws, ordinances, and regulations regarding vacation rentals, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0358 Relating to Athletic Coaches for Youth Athletic Teams** Ring
Athletic Coaches for Youth Athletic Teams; Revising the definition of the term "athletic coach"; expanding provisions relating to athletic coaches for independent sanctioning authorities to require such authorities to conduct specified background screening of certain coaches of youth athletic teams; providing that the duty may not be delegated; providing for disqualification; providing for exemption from disqualification; requiring that specified documentation be maintained for a specified period by such authorities, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0360 Relating to Sentencing for Controlled Substance Violations** Bradley
Sentencing for Controlled Substance Violations; Providing that a person who knowingly sells, purchases, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, specified quantities of hydrocodone, or any salt, derivative, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, or any mixture containing any such substance, commits the offense of trafficking in hydrocodone; providing that a person who knowingly sells, purchases, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, specified quantities of oxycodone, or any salt, derivative, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, or any mixture containing any such substance, commits the offense of trafficking in oxycodone, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0366 Relating to Public Records/Trade Secrets/Computers** Brandes
Public Records/Trade Secrets/Computers; Amending an exemption from public records requirements for data, programs, and supporting documentation that are trade secrets residing or existing internal or external to a computer, computer system, or computer network; expanding the exemption to include such trade secret information residing or existing internal or external to an electronic device; providing for legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: On the same date that SB 364 or

similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law

- SB 0374 Relating to Growth Management** Detert
Growth Management; Revising restrictions on an initiative or referendum process with regard to local comprehensive plan amendments and map amendments, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
- SB 0386 Relating to Application of Foreign Law in Courts** Hays
Application of Foreign Law in Courts; Defining the term “strong public policy”; prohibiting a court from enforcing certain choice of law or forum selection contractual provisions; requiring a court to review judgments and orders of foreign courts for comity before enforcing such orders or judgments; specifying judgments and orders of foreign courts that are not entitled to comity; providing that the attempt to apply the law of a foreign country is void under certain circumstances; prohibiting a trial court from dismissing an action on the grounds that a satisfactory remedy may be more conveniently sought in a foreign country; providing an exception, etc. Effective Date: On October 1, 2014
- SB 0390 Relating to Public Records/Identifying Information of Personnel of Department of Health** Hays
Public Records/Identifying Information of Personnel of Department of Health; Providing an exemption from public records requirements for certain identifying information of specific current and former personnel of the Department of Health and the spouses and children of such personnel, under specified circumstances; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
- SB 0392 Relating to State Speed Zones** Brandes
State Speed Zones; Raising the maximum allowable speed limit on certain highways; increasing the maximum allowable speed limit on roadways under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0398 Relating to Florida Tourism Hall of Fame** Detert
Florida Tourism Hall of Fame; Establishing the Florida Tourism Hall of Fame; providing for administration by the Florida Tourism Industry Marketing Corporation; designating a location for the display of inductee plaques; providing procedures for nomination, selection, and induction of members; providing that a person inducted before a certain date remains in the Hall of Fame, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2014
- SB 0404 Relating to Professional Geology** Grimsley
Professional Geology; Revising examination requirements for professional geologists; providing requirements for registration as a geologist-in-training; requiring geologist-in-training applicants to successfully complete the fundamentals of geology portion of the licensure examination; requiring the department to register each person as a geologist-in-training whom the board certifies has successfully completed the fundamentals portion of the geology examination, etc. Effective Date: 1/1/2015
- HB 0405 Relating to Trusts** Peters

Trusts: Limits liability of excluded trustees; provides that certain duties of trustees do not apply to excluded trustee in certain circumstances. Effective Date: July 1, 2014

- HB 0409 Relating to Offenses Against Vulnerable Persons** Passidomo
Offenses Against Vulnerable Persons: Revising when an out of court statement by an elderly person or disabled adult is admissible in certain proceedings; expanding applicability of prohibition on the fraudulent use of personal identification information of specified victims without consent to include persons 60 years of age or older; deleting a requirement that property of an elderly person or disabled adult be obtained by deception or intimidation in order to constitute exploitation of such a person; creating the Identity Theft and Fraud Grant Program, etc. Effective Date: October 1, 2014
- HB 0413 Relating to Consumer Collection Practices** Santiago
